D String

0 0 0 0 0 0 0 1 1 1 1 1 1 1

Open D String - called "D" 1st finger on the D String - called "E"

2 2 2 2 2 2 2 3 3 3 3 3 3 3

2nd finger on the D string - called "F#" (sharp) 3rd finger on the D string - called "G"

A String

0 0 0 0 0 0 0 1 1 1 1 1 1 1

Open A - Called "A" 1st finger on the A string - called "B"

2 2 2 2 2 2 2 3 3 3 3 3 3 3

2nd finger on the A string - called "C#" (sharp) 3rd finger on the A string - called "D"

Notice that the notes get higher on the staff as the fingers are placed on the string.
