Enrollment, class size and qualifications

Complete all enrollment papers

Must meet qualifications

Limited to 10 Pre-K students. Waiting list if class is full

Qualifications:

Must be toilet trained. No diapers or pull ups

Every Preschooler will be on a 2-week probation for classroom behavior if he or she is not ready for school, meaning ready to sit, listen to the teacher, follow directions, hits or bullies another child he/she will be asked to withdraw

Must attend on time or early. LATE students may also be asked to withdraw due to too much tardiness.

School hours/ Drop off and pick up/Breakfast -lunch

Enter and exit through Kiss n' Go

7:20-7:50 AM Breakfast Pre-K must be here by **7:30 AM** to allow time for them to eat and finish by **7:50 AM**

8AM Flag salute; Morning announcements

8-12:30 PM Class time

11-11:40 AM Lunch will be on the school side on the picnic tables with their teacher
 Play time will be at the school side playground only

12:15PM Start to line up for Pick up through Kiss n 'Go
 Pick up your Pre-K student on time. You can get in line for Kiss n'go as early as 12:15 PM.

12:20 PM Pre-K line up in the courtyard to be dismissed
 Pick up your Pre-K on time. If you have other students K-6th their release time is different.

Do not pick up your other students early, as the STATE requires so many teaching minutes every day.

We do report all students and their minutes to the STATE.

Pre-K minutes are not reported. However, when you enroll your Pre-K student please respect the times they are to be in school.

School communication:

Parents MUST attend Meet the Teacher, which is usually the 2nd day of school

7:30-8. Call the office 480 655-7444 if you student is **not** going to attend school

Students are NOT to attend school if he/she is sick.

TEXT messages - you will receive TEXT messages regarding school events.

Messages pertain to the entire school, not one specific grade.

This does not affect Pre-K as they are always released at 12:30 PM .

New Horizon School follows a school uniform policy to promote school unity, and standards of dress. All students must follow the below standards of dress, hair, and what is required and not permitted.

REQUIRED UNIFORM:

- Navy blue sweat pants, sweat shorts (to the knee) or dazzle navy blue shorts.
 - These may be ordered when the school purchases them, which is usually 3 times a year.
 - You can order pants or shorts from Hanes, Wal-Mart or Target.
- School T-shirt either red or navy blue with the school logo.
 - These must be purchased from the school.
- Uniforms **MUST** be kept clean, no holes, in the shirts, pants or shorts.
- Suggested number to purchase.
 - 6 New Horizon School T-shirts at least one **RED** one for some performances or field trips.
 - 4 pair of long navy-blue sweat pants
 - 4 pair of sweat pants or dazzle shorts

PERMITTED

- Flexible light weight tennis shoes
- Sweatshirts and hoodie jackets when weather permits
- Unscented deodorant
- Studs (only) earrings for girls

NOT PERMITTED

- Leggings
- Knee high socks
- Layered clothing unless New Horizon shirt is on top.
- Hele shoes
- Perfume, cologne or makeup (light makeup can be worn for performances).
- Jewelry, necklaces, ear-rings only studs for girls, bracelets. Etc.

HAIR

- We prefer Long hair to the shoulders be pulled back in a pony tail.
- No faddish styles such as: spiked, shaved heads, mohawks, unnatural colors.

\$\$\$ DOLLARS FOR DUDS Friday's ONLY - NO \$ Dollars for Duds for Pre-K students

- Students can pay \$1.00 (cash) when they come to school on Fridays to be allowed to wear clothing of their choice, with school standards and below regulations.
- **PERMITTED:** long pants, long jeans (no ripped jeans, or holes in clothing) Shorts to the knee, regular tennis shoes and socks.
- **NOT PERMITTED:** No dresses, skirts, no shirts with no sleeves, or sleeveless tops, or tank tops. No shirts with any kinds of bad language, or advertising such as alcohol, foul language, obscene pictures on the shirts.
No boots or crazy socks. NO knee-high socks. Must have shoes and socks.
